

A Doll's House is a three-act play written by Norwegian playwright Henrik Ibsen (March 20,1828 – May 23,1906). The play is set in a Norwegian town circa

1879 and concerns the fate of a married woman, who at the time in Norway lacked reasonable opportunities for self-fulfillment in a male-dominated world, despite the fact that Ibsen denied it was his intent to write a feminist play. It was a great sensation at the time, and caused a "storm of outraged controversy" that went beyond the theatre to the world of newspapers and society.

their interest in taking it off our hands. We prefer not to do that but we must keep that possibility as an option.

John Nyseth built our Parade Float, has stored it at his house and has pulled it in almost 50 parades. But now it is time to move it on to a new home and a new loving caretaker. The boat is on a trailer and when the mast is down it will fit inside most garages. The disassembled dimensions are about 8 feet wide by 16 feet long by 7 feet high.

This is a beautiful representation of a Viking Ship and one that our Lodge can be proud of. If you have a garage or other building where we can store it or if you know of another place, please let one of the Trustees (Jim Larson, Don Jensen and Dianne Snell) know. It would be ideal if you are also able to pull it in parades but that is not necessary.
